

Chapter Names

Chapters are known as chapters of Professional Engineers Ontario.

Who initially decided on my chapter's name?

- Council.

Where should I use my chapter's official name?

- On your chapter's stationery, official letters, websites, newsletters, documents, announcements, and public notices (pertaining to activities engaged in by your chapter).

Can my chapter's name be changed?

- With approval, yes.
- The name change has to be approved by Chapter Executives, a majority of members at the AGM, Regional Congress, and ultimately PEO Council.

As of June 2014, there were a total of 36 chapters, as listed below.

Western : Brantford, Chatham-Kent, Georgian Bay, Grand River, Hamilton-Burlington, Lambton, London, Niagara, and Windsor-Essex (9)

West Central: Brampton, Etobicoke, Kingsway, Mississauga, Oakville, Toronto-Humber, and West Toronto (7)

East Central: East Toronto, Lake Ontario, Scarborough, Simcoe-Muskoka, Willowdale-Thornhill, and York (6)

Eastern: Algonquin, Kingston, Ottawa, Peterborough, Quinte, Thousand Islands, and Upper Canada (7)

Northern: Algoma, Lakehead, Lake-of-the-Woods, North Bay, Porcupine/Kapuskasing, Sudbury, and Temiskaming (7)
