

MOTION 1

Whereas: OSPE has demanded that the Ontario Government take the following actions against PEO;

Immediately, as a temporary measure, revoke PEO's power of self-regulation and place it under trusteeship of the provincial government, just like Quebec did from 2016-2019.

For long-term sustainability, this regulatory reform, should establish an independent body, like the Office of the Superintendent of Professional Governance (OSPG) in British Columbia, who will be responsible for ensuring consistent and independent oversight of all professional regulators.

Whereas: OSPE as Advocate for engineers in Ontario has launched efforts contrary to their mission to work for licensed engineers to raise awareness and relevance of engineering.

Be it resolved: that Eastern Region Chapters of PEO cease all contact and work with OSPE until public retraction of attacks against PEO are made.

MOTION 2

We request funds which are not spent due to Covid 19 to be accumulated for the next year. This implies that there would be an exemption from the Bank-balance rule, so that unspent money does not penalize chapters.

MOTION 3

Treasurers of each Chapter should be receiving detailed monthly statements detailing all transactions conducted by the Chapter for tracking. Currently, only the account balance per month is provided which is not sufficient for maintaining and reporting financial records. We request that staffs send detailed monthly statements to the Chapters.
